

Adult Table Display Guidelines

1. A display of items presented by any group including Branches of the British Sugarcraft Guild; other Sugarcraft groups; a group of individuals or colleges. A group is defined as two or more persons combining their skills.
2. As a minimum the table display should contain the following 6 elements:
 - Royal iced cake – *a regular shaped cake or dummy*
 - Sugarpaste cake – *a regular shaped cake or dummy*
 - Miniature – *a smaller version of the real thing to fit within a 6 inch/15cm cube*
 - Marzipan model
 - Sugar floral exhibit
 - Pastillage – *a freestanding item (eg top ornament, box, card, figure etc)*The elements may be produced by one member or by team members working together.
3. One piece of work, not included in the items in point 2 above, can be made from a non edible medium, eg cold porcelain, Artista Soft™ etc.
4. The display should be the co-operative work of the members of the group, encouraging participation of members irrespective of their levels of ability or experience.
5. Each element will earn a maximum of nine points, making up a potential total of 50% of the points allocated. The remaining 50% will be allocated for compliance with the schedule; creativity and originality and visual impact.
6. In addition to awarding certificates for First, Second, Third and Highly Commended, the following trophies will be awarded: Best Royal Iced Cake, Best Non-Edible Exhibit, Best Sugar Floral Art and Best in Show.
7. Table size approximately 6 feet 9 inches/206cm x 4 feet/122 cm x 27¼ inches/69cm.

Young Sugarcrafters Table Display Guidelines

1. A display of items presented by any group including Cygnets of the British Sugarcraft Guild, other Sugarcraft groups or a group of individuals. A group is defined as two or more persons combining their skills.
2. The display should be the co-operative work of the members of the group, encouraging participation of members irrespective of their levels of ability or experience.
3. The display will be judged on creativity, originality and visual impact.
4. Certificates are awarded for First, Second, Third and Highly Commended.
5. Table size approximately 3 feet/92cm x 2 feet/60cm.

General Guidelines

1. Displays should be set up between 8.30am and 9.45am and should not be dismantled or removed before 4.00pm. Judging will start at 10.00am.
2. Work must not have been previously displayed.
3. The name of the group may be displayed on the table.
4. The venue is unable to cater for electrical items on the display tables. Only battery operated items allowed.
5. The decision of the Chair of Judges shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
